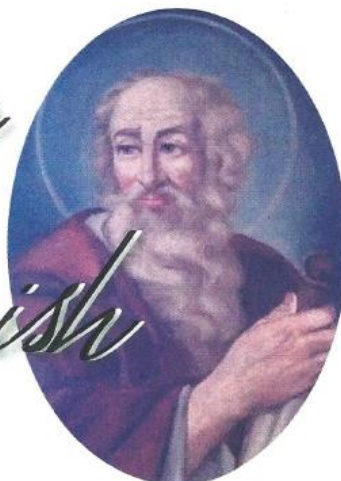

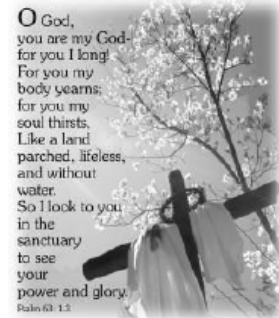

Our Journey in Faith

The Temple of Jerusalem was the most important center of Jewish worship. It was built and rebuilt to hold the ark of the covenant which was contained in the holy of holies, the most sacred part of the temple, and had two altars outside for sacrifice and incense. The courtyard had money changers (only Jewish coins were permitted) and various shops where people bought animals and birds for sacrificial offerings. As time passed the business of the courtyard became a distraction and the scene of haggling over the price of offerings was the situation that occasioned Jesus to confront what was going on. The Fathers house was being desecrated and becoming a den of thieves!

Aside from the external show of man's baser desires for money and commerce, Jesus rightly points to something far more profound - the reality of each of us being the Temple of God. He Himself refers to His being the temple that would be destroyed and rebuilt in three days. This is a reference to His death and resurrection - not understood at the time, but came to be confirmed in the minds of His disciples. Moreover we too must be temples of the Lord.

During this Lenten season, the temples of our hearts and souls must be cleansed so that God can rightly reside therein. When one thinks of all the discordant traffic that goes on within us, we well recognize the need for this cleansing.

Let us ask the Lord Jesus to enter under our roofs and cleanse us all of our sins. Unworthy, though that we may be, this forgiveness and love can work miracles.

In 70 AD the Temple of Jerusalem was destroyed and never rebuilt.
