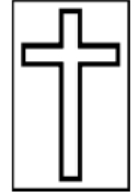

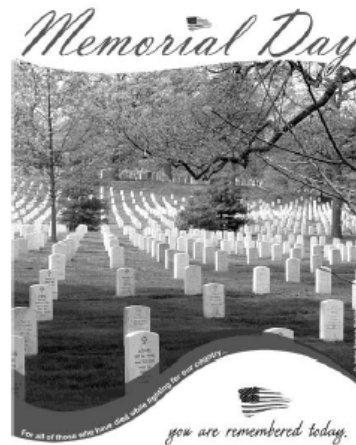

Living today with all that is going on is quite a challenge to the faith we have in Jesus, the Christ. Some would say that it is over the top, that our values and behavior seems to know no bounds - no real concern for others, for society as a whole, nor for our own integrity. How does a person touched by God cope in a society where depravity is highlighted in the media and where even our civil leaders behave with such indiscretion as to embarrass us all. Did Jesus not come to change the behavior and values of humanity? Certainly this is the message of the Scriptures and the longstanding teachings of our church. Perhaps we have a lost a sense of who we

are - that we were created in God's image and likeness ordained to uphold God's laws and His will. Moreover recognizing our weaknesses God sent His son to redeem us - to lift us out of our misery of selfishness and sin, to live in imitation of His goodness, holiness, and peace. With both the natural and supernatural aide God has given us, one would hope for better results. But living in a world that edifies greed, lust, power and selfism, we know the struggle goes on, and as the years pass, with greater intensity.

This struggle mimics the struggle of Jesus in The Garden of Gethsemane wherein Jesus prayed with such intensity but victoriously ceded to do God's will. It also brings to mind the fears that His disciples faced in the upper room when faced with the prospects of an angry mob. Knowing what was ahead of them and of us, Jesus promised that The Father would send The Holy Spirit as our advocate to show us a way of living in this turbulent world. But we must open ourselves to receive Him. We must be malleable in the face of God's assistance and strong in our resolve to listen to Him, to be reborn in Him. Remember although we are in the world, we are not of the world. In Christ we must find our strength.
