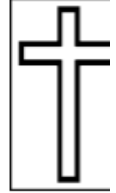

It is not an exalted notion of sex, but a tawdry, in your face approach to every aspect and detail. Children are weaned on this and the rest of society glibly gives their acceptance. If so the person is a neanderthal and just doesn't get it!

It is to such a society that the church must speak. It is in some ways similar to that which Moses had to face. He points the way in his search for God, the very God who promises to be always with us. But we must repent. We must get over our fixation with sex and things sensual. We must reach out to the transcendent one who is the only one who can capture our hearts and lead us safely into heaven.
