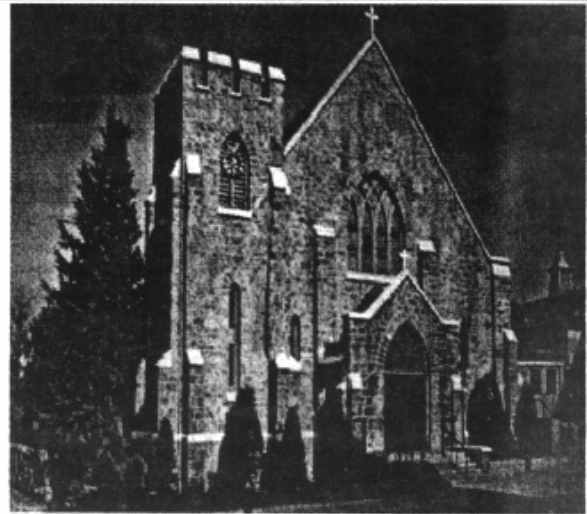

VOCATIONS



The year of St. Paul June 2008 to June 29, 2009.

At this time of the fifty days as we think and pray for the experience of being with the Risen Lord we can ask ourselves what is God's Plan for this special revelation. During the fifty days before Pentecost the review of the Christ event after the Resurrection gives us the time to listen and to plan. At the Last Supper Jesus told the Apostles that He was going ahead to prepare a place for His faithful. During that preparatory time He would not be with them in the usual manner of being sensibly present to their company. What the new presence meant was something for which special preparation was necessary.

The coming of the Holy Spirit was the introduction of the New Christ Life Way that believers would come to the Truth. In the Gospel of John the gift of the Holy Spirit was the fulfillment of their Easter life. Instead of Death that had crowned them, hiding as they were in fear at the upper room, they received Life when Jesus, Risen, entered the room – the doors being locked.

First at that moment was the gift of peace. "Peace be with you" he said. The second gift He offered was the Holy Spirit and the forgiveness through the Spirit of their sins. "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven. Whose sins you retain are retained."

The gift of the Spirit was a gift to the whole Church. In the Acts of the Apostles, the waiting time for the Church was fifty days – the occasion of Pentecost. We are in that waiting period now.

St. Paul whose experience with the Risen Lord is beyond our capacity to understand knew well the powerful work of the Holy Spirit. In writing to the Corinthians he said "To each individual the manifestations of the Spirit is given for some benefit." (1 Cor. 12:7).

As we wait for that Holy Spirit we can be focusing on His coming and the benefit He will give. Different for each. The same in fulfillment of wonder.
