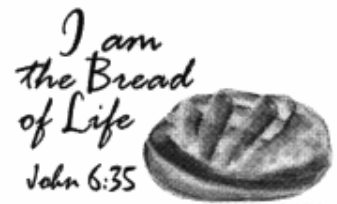

# VOCATIONS



The year of the Priesthood June 19, 2009 to June 11, 2010.

We think of God's grace as strengthening or enlightening the human condition with heaven as the intervening power of God's hand in human life. When I recall my first seminary year, one intervening human influence on me was a transient deacon from my home parish who would be ordained June 5, 1950 – Michael Flannery. My earliest memory of him was a snowy Sunday morning when I was in the third grade. Going to Mass that morning I had to walk five blocks to 168<sup>th</sup> St and three blocks to Shakespeare Ave where Sacred Heart Church was located. My mother stood beside me on the porch. She was looking and waiting for the Flannery brothers, Mickey & Johnny. When they would pass our house she would entrust me to their care. Job well done. I departed and arrived back home safely.

Whatever constitutes the make-up of a hero, let each one decide. Mike, as he was then called, was my hero. During that first Dunwoodie year Mike, Mickey regularly offered a good word so needed by new arrivals. Mike was six feet one and had a smile that easily raised anyone's spirit. The cheerful sound of his voice enlightened the soul with understanding that life was wonderful.

So at the end of April before ordination, Mike asked what work I would do in the summer. Answer! A Yankee Stadium Club waiter. With a quick retort Mike asked if I had told the rector. No, I had not. Better speak to him. A week passed. What did the rector say? I did not mention it to him. Better do so.

I went to the rector to inform him about the summer job. The surprised rector told me that there was a bishop in the archdiocese who would recommend expulsion from the seminary if he heard of a seminarian serving alcohol. The end. Leaving, the rector tried to be light-hearted, "Why not try third base?"

Why did I have to listen to Mike Flannery? In hindsight, Mike's advice was probably life saving.

As I served Mike's first Mass June 5, 1950 at Sacred Heart Church I was having intermittent distractions over the Yankee Club loss. The job then that summer had me focused at a hot dog counter in the lower deck of Yankee Stadium. That defeat ended five summers working for Harry M Stevens, the caterer at Yankee Stadium. Hot dog then – fifteen cents. The Stadium loss was soon forgotten. I never mentioned to Mike the heartbreak spun out by the rector.

Shocked though was I to learn that the rector knew that Mike was a Rockaway lifeguard – and four other seminarians ordained June 5<sup>th</sup> were, too. What was the difference between booze and beach?
