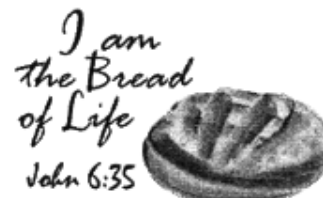

The year of the Priesthood June 19, 2009 to June 11, 2010.

Arriving at the seminary in 1949 held a blessing that we did not imagine because reality can block the lived experience of what was not our past. To think that children in these days are not able to imagine the past as a time in which television did not exist helps us to realize what progress means. Our blessing in 1949 came from the compassion of Cardinal Spellman. After the war in 1945 he began modernizing seminary living conditions. One especially touched us.

Until then in the morning each seminarian had to go to the bathroom at the end of the hall and there fill his pitcher with water - hot/cold - and return to his room. There the water was poured into a basin and the morning ritual began. The Cardinal changed this venerable practice. In 1949 every room had its own sink with running hot & cold water making the 5:30AM rising just a bit more bearable. How many ever say, once in a year, "Tom Edison, thanks." How many times did pre-Spellman seminarians who had no running water in the room say, "Thanks, your Eminence" or with true affection say, "Spelly, you're the man."

At 6AM everyone was in the prayer hall for morning meditation. In that first week a gray haired priest was waiting at the prayer hall door as everyone entered. He closed the door as the 6AM bell was ringing. In those years, on average, priests were ordained at twenty six years. A rare few there were who would be ordained with years beyond twenty six. Most of us with that understanding presumed that the gray haired priest at the door was the rector, Monsignor Fearn. No questions about that conviction.

The next Sunday at 6AM a different priest, much younger than the gray head, was at the door, and the gray head was sitting with the fourth year students, the second theologians. The door keeper porter was a seminarian who was ordained with minor orders, one being the order of porter, or door keeper. Each one in that fourth year had the job for a week.

Jim Tobin was the gray haired seminarian at the door our first week at Dunwoodie. Jim then was in his early forties, two years away from ordination to the priesthood after which he spent most of his time as English teacher at Stepinac High School in White Plains, New York. Priests in our class have always noted, "Don't do a Jim Tobin" i.e., get the facts first. Do they also recall Cardinal Spellman who saved us from the bowl and pitcher?
