VOCATIONS

The year of St. Paul June 2008 to June 29, 2009. Ancient Israel had a relation to God through the covenant and the law and the temple. Justification of a person depended upon entering into the faith that the covenants imaged. The covenant laws acted upon in that faith developed then the character of righteousness. Thus in this process was a certain union of minds of the person and of God. Paul was exact and almost rigid in his effort. Awareness of the human effort could diminish the sense of faith. Once someone was attending to his/her effort, the focus of God at the center was shifting to another point - the human point.

St. Paul's experience of new light and new life in Jesus Christ brought forth a new vision. Covenant, law and temple were fulfilled in the resurrection from the death of Jesus.

Life after death? Some believed in a general resurrection at the end of time when the righteous of their day had fulfilled all of the requirements for justification. Others said the dead went to the shadows - Shoal. For others death was the end of it all. Jesus? He was alive and present in a transfigured body.

For Paul Jesus was the fulfillment of life, the answer to the mystery of suffering and happiness, of good and evil. The act of Jesus that is called, Redemptive suffering and death that Jesus experienced in his mortal body, has opened for all the union with Him in His resurrected Presence signified in this transformed body that went beyond death. Through that Jesus gift of love for us, we are joined to Him in faith. With this faith is needed our response to Him in our good works. Faith is awareness of Jesus, Savior. Love is our participation with Him as we share in the suffering of humanity with the understanding that all suffering reveals Christ. Alleviation of all suffering goes beyond self to others and to whatever situations need human compassion.
