VOCATIONS

The year of St. Paul June 2008 - June 29, 2009. Some people have a sense of St. Paul as intolerant, severe, one-sided and even prejudiced. Quite a framework to describe a man. Paul did not indicate any of these aspects in his approach to others.

To think of Paul as a man opposed to the Way of Jesus one needs to understand the driving faith that moved him in his relation to God. Paul, the Pharisee was a very learned man who used his mind to give people direction in their call from God who needed a response of personal belief. God's call was the whole story that Israel attempted to fathom through the religious rituals of the Pentateuch. Paul became upset when some people of Israel turned from Moses to Jesus, abandoning the one faith that sprang from the loins of Abraham. Paul aimed to halt this defection that was arising.

Paul was vague about what the heresy of Jesus meant. What Paul understood was that salvation came through the Law. To follow Moses was the achievement of holiness. There was no other way. In that regard Paul was intolerant, severe, one-sided and prejudiced. God loved Paul.

When the conversion came, it was Jesus who dealt directly with Paul, "why are you persecuting me?" Just meditate on that exchange and the follow-up learning that Paul received in the Spirit. Paul was transformed. Not through the Law did a person become justified. Justification i.e being made right, righteous, loved and understandably Loved by God, through the offering of Jesus to the Father - this was the whole power that revealed the majesty of Jesus in the mind of Paul and made Paul the apostolic communication of Jesus' love. Paul was not a fanatic, prejudiced or severe. He was a believer. And the fulness of belief came in the exchange with Jesus that stunned this Saint.
