ST. MARIA GORETTI, PRAY FOR US

June 2008 - June 2009 - Year of St. Paul the Apostle. Since the days of Martin Luther the understanding of St. Paul's writings have been interpreted as the work of a man who was filled with the need for good works to fulfill personal responsibilities that would gain God's favor. A kind of "pay what you owe" exchange. Surely we owe God everything beginning with life itself.

In the developing understanding of Paul researchers have come to recognize more than the obligation to earn what is God's favor. Emphasis is not placed essentially on the law. Rather the call of God's people to enter a covenant with God has become the new and arresting focus. God's people were God's people because of a covenant God made with them. This gift of God was exactly that, a gift.

Where emphasis centers on the covenant, one's identity as beloved by God is foremost defined as the union of love. From that union the demand of the law became expressions that obedience calls for, when one is in love. Obedience follows love that makes the requirements of the law most reasonable. This note is seen in the letter to the Galatians. "For you were called for freedom, brothers. But do not use this freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, rather serve one another through love. For the whole law is filled in one statement, namely, "you shall love your neighbor as yourself". (Gal. 5:13-14)

Love from God to the individual is a complete circle when it is fulfilled, "your neighbor as yourself." We learn by giving away, not by counting, by earning - by putting the squeeze on God.
