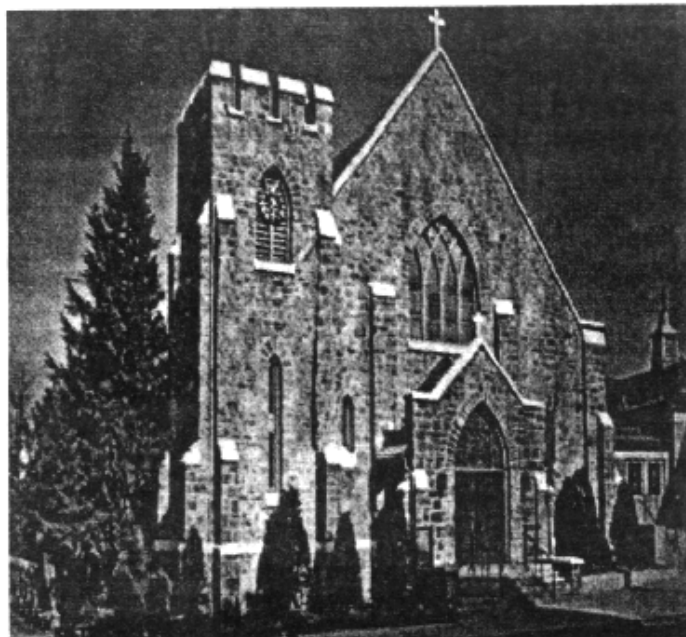

The year of the Priesthood June 19, 2009 to June 19, 2010.

It was 1949, Sept. 7th. In the Bronx the day was warm but muggy. I was finishing the packing that my mother said should have been completed before this last minute. My suitcase was packed. Not another washrag would fit that traveler's bag that would be taken with me to St Joseph's Seminary, Yonkers, New York. Where Yonkers was located I did not know. A few miles past the Woodlawn-Jerome station at the tip of the Bronx.

On that September Monday we were celebrating the feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Mother – the traditional day for the Seminary school year to begin. At two in the afternoon my mother asked if I wanted some steak and a baked potato – truly the end all and be all. Far beyond the chopped meat special. I thought that the offering of mom was more than generous and thoughtful and indeed beyond the touch of special. At that moment, I declined. "No mom," I said, "it is the opening day at the seminary and we'll probably have some kind of feast." Wouldn't they want to lift the hearts of the young men who were preparing for the altar of God?

The auto ride that evening to the seminary was the gift of Jim Docherty and Richie Fhlor. We had the borrowed car of Mrs. Ray Reidy, the aunt of Jimmy "Doc". We reached our destination in twenty five minutes. They chatted with me, wished me luck and I departed to a new life.

Rooms were assigned. Dinner at six. Dress – cassock. Table at the lower end of the dining room. The dinner – liverwurst and canned wax beans. We never at home ate vegetables out of the can. Steak and baked potato? What was this sensory experience to be like? Never mind the dining room table, there were many other aspects of seminary life that we would meet with surprise.
