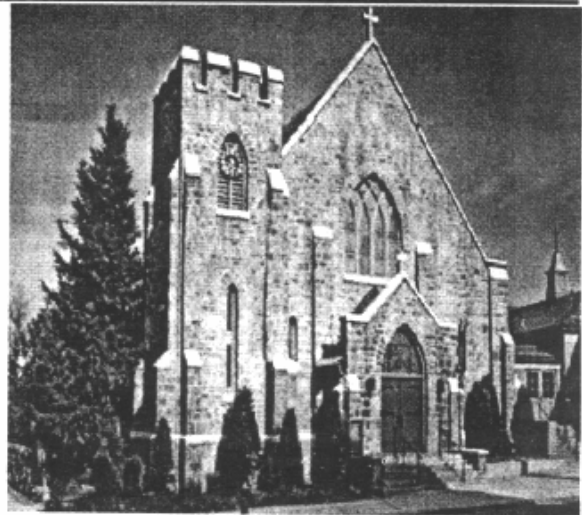

The year of St. Paul June 2008 to June 29, 2009.

Our belief in everlasting life is a flow continuous since Jesus spoke two thousand years ago. Acceptance and appreciation of this tenet of faith brings us before Jesus Himself. We believe because He claimed us as His own. In His death-sacrifice He died for each and all. Who are we then? St. Paul is very clear; "...heirs, heirs of God and joint heirs of Christ, if only we suffer with Him so that we may also be glorified with Him." (Rom. 8:17)

In the past two hundred years some thinkers of these times have been trying to teach allegiance to reason as the salvation that human beings want. But reason alone has failed. After World War I the conclusion that reason was our hope was shown to be a miserable failure. Without the hope of reason the spirit of hope began to disappear. Sin was proving to be definite power. And the suffering of the people after 1918 in Europe formed a concrete template that could receive hopelessness and form it into despair. That set the stage for whatever anarchy could be set up. Those were days of suffering, the kind that St. Paul referenced in the letter to the Romans, "if only we suffer with him", that is, to see suffering with the eyes of Christ. And therefore to recognize and accept the way of the Lord. But no. Bigger and better armies were hailed as the saving power of the day. And so began the quiet movement to remove Easter from the pages of history. When Jesus died on the Cross that was the end. Thus there is no Easter, no Resurrection. There are no heirs to claim the treasure, the love of "Abba", Father. So necessary for us to sing, "Glory to God in the highest".
