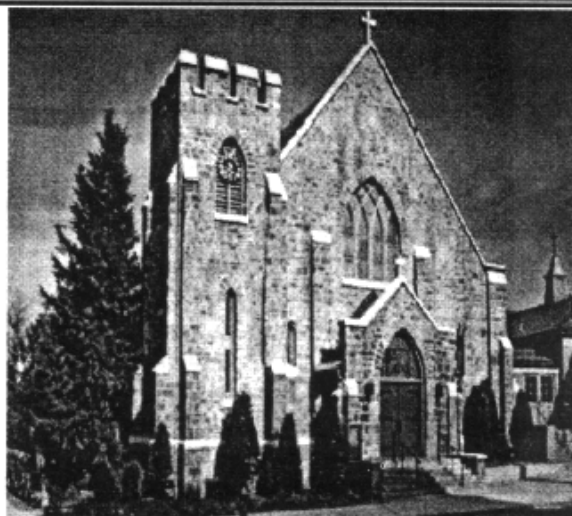

Everyone who is baptized and has struggles with the understanding that unfolds through the way of the Spirit has a deepening appreciation of the company of Jesus. How very important to be aware of that condition of love that is the mainstay of the needed balance that supports love's true meaningful experience. That strength is releasing sacrifice. Sacrifice that offers hope beyond apparent failure and joy arising from defeat manifests God's grace that is the union of Jesus in one's effort to live the Christian experiment.

At all times a person has to be on guard for the subtle attacks that arise from nowhere and threaten faith, that foundational gift of God that once accepted has to be secured. St. Paul reminds us of the course that can guide our steps, "...we await the blessed hope, the appearance of the glory of the great God and of our Savior Jesus Christ, who gave Himself for us to deliver us from all lawlessness and to cleanse for Himself a people as His own, eager to do what is good." (Titus 2:13.)

Thus we have an identity – we are in Christ. Today we are aware of a frightening phenomenon that silently draws people into a devastating mess – computer identity theft, clipping the fastest growing users of social networking websites. Facebook being the most vulnerable. Our identity as Christian is under siege because of what the spirit of the world offers. From this spirit Christ "has delivered us" so that we can be "eager to do what is good". That does not mean that our problems are solved. Our solution to problems unites us to the mystery of the Cross. We need to be thoughtful, reasonable, sensible to identify the bad from the good. And frequently to struggle for the good. Therein is discovered the strength of sacrifice.
