VOCATIONS



The year of St. Paul June 2008 to June 29, 2009.

With his thought staggered by the mystery of the cross Paul had become aware that salvation, the hoped for restoration of the relation between God and the people, was primarily the work of God. People had a vague idea of God's justice, i.e. his aim to bring his people back to His heart. Justification, righteousness was God's work and not the effort that a person put into doing the good that coincided with God's work. Salvation is a sheer gift.

The truth that led to salvation was summarized in the decalogue, the ten commandments – all of which made sense. These were indeed marks of reasoning that touched the intrinsic flow of natural thinking to achieve what was good. The Law was blessed. The experience of Paul though brought forth the fulfillment of God's Plan beyond commandments. Paul was a person whose appreciation of the law was rock solid. He knew that the strenuous effort he made to live in accord with the Law gave him the title to salvation. His faithfulness to God's love was manifest before God in following the careful details of the Law that motivated Paul to offer spiritual worship.

God, always a step ahead, gave Paul a new vision that contrasted the way of the Law with the way of the Cross. In Romans 10:13, For "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved". Paul went beyond the commandments after a person designated, Messiah, by Christians. At once Paul sought to arrest these infidels. His conversion though changed his plan, his life and his love. Did the sorrow of Paul for his own people cast him into despair as he looked beyond the transformed meaning of his own religious life in its fulfillment through the cross and resurrection of Jesus? No. "But in respect to election, they are beloved because of the patriarchs. For the gifts and the call of God are irrevocable" (Rom. 11:28b – 29). Paul never lost his love for his own people. His love of God was so depth-filled that he understood what mercy meant. "God has delivered all to disobedience, that he might have mercy upon all" (Rom.11:32). In trying to understand the wickedness of the Original Sin that has consequences now – begin with the mercy of God to discover at the cross what Paul recognized.
