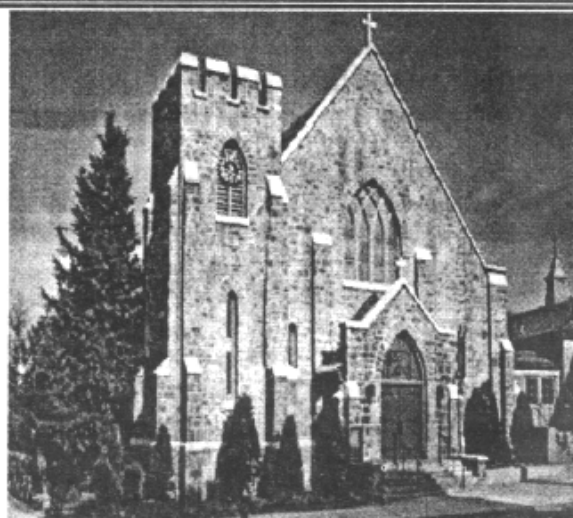

VOCATIONS



The year of St. Paul June 2008 to June 29, 2009.

Trying to imagine what Paul's experience was after the time of his conversion becomes a daunting matter. Here we have a very holy man. His strict sense of what God looks for in human beings made him very demanding on himself and on others given the new enlightenment that was his.

In one instance we note the transposition of meaning for the familiar ritual practice of temple worship. A new status of sacrifice he recognized through his deepening faith. This spiritual direction, new light, was explosive in the relation of human beings to God. "I appeal to you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship." (Rom. 12:1)

Sacrifice in the temple presumed the destruction of the victim. The animal was burned, and some remains of the animal were eaten by the people to indicate their sharing of life with God. Charged to give worship to God, becoming a "living sacrifice" has a profound implication. The human being becomes the sign of God's love in the flesh. The whole person standing forth in the exchange with others in day to day relationships, Paul called to become sacred - i.e. a living sacrifice, one with vitality. Holy. What is holy can be a thing, a place, but here the 'holy' is a person. Acceptable to God, a new biblical expression of genuine sacrifice. Thus the Christian's life is recognized by Paul as a new way of living. The person in his/her total make-up endowed with reason, becomes the presence of adoration and glorification of the living God.
