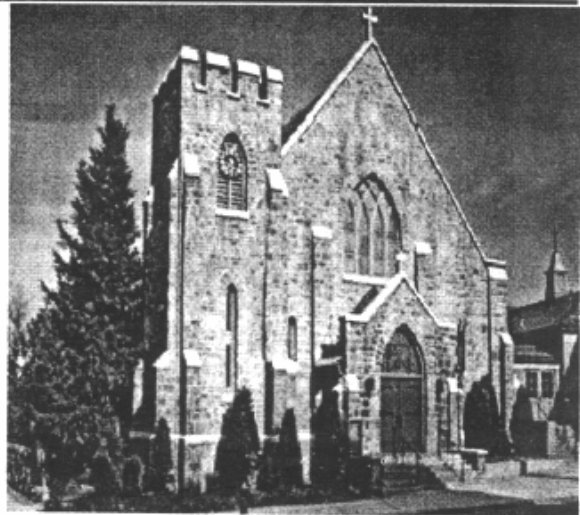

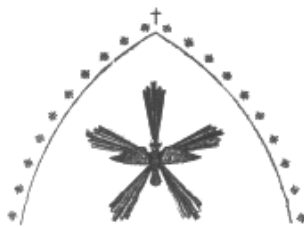

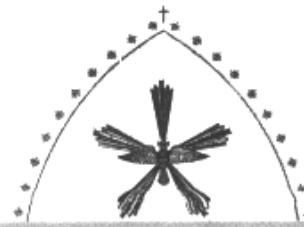

VOCATIONS



The year of St. Paul June 2008 to June 29, 2009.

We live two thousand years after St Paul and in those two thousand years great changes have occurred. In Yonkers, the fourth largest city of the state of New York, one finds twenty two church buildings from which to choose. In St Paul's time no church building with the church themes and composition as we know, existed.

At the very beginning of Christianity those first Christians were Jewish. So the Jewish-Christians continued their familiar practice of gathering for the service of 'the word' at the synagogue (meaning gathering-together-place). The synagogue was founded during the time of the exile (587 B.C.-537 B.C.) when the people did not have the temple. The traditional sacrifices were eliminated. What they could do was discuss and pray the Torah.

A synagogue could be established in any community that had ten men to lead it. When the first Christians had meditated and prayed the torah, they moved on to someone's home. There the Eucharist was celebrated in the breaking of the bread at the home that could accommodate a small gathering of perhaps twenty. Where there was a wealthy family in residence, as many as forty could be accommodated. The service was led by someone who in some way had an apostolic connection.

Paul refers to "church, churches" but not meaning a building. Rather a group or a community. It was not until after the persecutions in Rome that the people came out of hiding in 317 A.D. The emperor Constantine, a convert to Christianity built the first Christian Basilica.
